Key benefits to clubs to consider are listed below in no particular order:

- > FREE fall & spring league! NO league fee!
- > FREE US Soccer Grassroots license courses (12 coaches for every 500 players registered rec or comp)
- > FREE access to MOJO curriculum for coaches
- > Players must be USYS registered and coaches must be Cal North background check approved
- > FREE background checks for 2022/2023 season (Background checks are \$14.15)
- > FREE player registration software with GotSport (GotSport charges \$3/player)
- > Player passes are \$18 for competitive and \$11.25 for recreational

Continued key benefits to clubs to consider are listed below in no particular order:

- > Each Cal North district will have it's own division (Gold, Silver, Bronze & Copper)
- > Club-based division AND individual team-based division
- > Club-based division will begin with 8U (more if clubs agree in year 1, and club must meet standards)
- > Club standards include coaching license program, referee program, Sideline Behavior Program, Soccer Parenting Program, participation in Cal North ODP Program

> Pathway to USYS Cal North regional conference league (CNPC)

> Pathway to Cal North State Cup events



#### DISTRICT DIVISIONS





#### Club vs. Club Divisions:

- > In 2022/2023, four clubs will be selected and approved > Club must be pre-approved each year
- > Clubs meet standards including coach license program, referee program and sideline behavior program
  - > Team and club division winners play-off for 1st place overall 12U-17U play for advancement into USYS CNPC league for upcoming fall season



#### DISTRICT **DIVISIONS**



#### Team vs. Team Divisions:

- > Gold, Silver, Bronze and Copper levels of play
- > Our goal is to have teams travel no more than 30 minutes for 8U-12U, and 45 minutes for 13U-19U
  - > Gold division winners are eligible for State Cup for 2022/2023 season
- > Team and club division winners play-off for 1st place overall
- > 12U-17U play for advancement into USYS CNPC league for the upcoming fall season



#### SCHEDULING PARAMETERS



#### Important Information:

> Teams will play 8-10 games in fall & spring season

> Include a High School break for the 15U-19U age groups

> Keep travel within reason (intentions are below):

8U-12U: Approx. 30 minutes

13U-19U: Approx. 45 minutes

> Cal North will provide scheduling & administration

> Cal North will provide player registration support

> Clubs will have flexibility to schedule gametime, fields & referees

#### CCSL BEST XI

Cal North will be implementing **CCSL Best XI** teams for the 2022/2023 year. These teams will provide recognition to standout players for their performance during the season. Head coaches in the Gold Divisions will use a nomination and voting process to select players into **CCSL Best XI** teams.

**CCSL Best XI** teams will be presented in a 4-4-2 formation with one goalkeeper, four defenders, four midfielders and two forwards.
